Community Updates

Claiborne Beach and Jetty Update – There are indications that illegal Beach and Jetty uses have declined since the Sheriff and the Department of Natural Resources have increased enforcement of park closing and illegal fishing rules. We have gained relief from recent nights with many fishermen on the Jetty, parties on the Beach and a dozen or more vehicles parked along Landing Road.

If you see cars and trucks parked along Landing Road after dark, people on the Beach or people fishing on the Jetty, please call the Sheriff's office at 410-822-1020 and report it. Sheriff Gamble has requested that we report any infraction.

Village Hall Update - Jack Harrald, Rob Todd and Kirke Harper met recently with Jim Bass of the Eastern Shore Land Conservancy, Kristin Baja of the Urban Sustainability Directors Network and Geneva Harrison, Talbot County's Emergency Management Coordinator, to discuss designating the Claiborne Resilience Center as a model Resilience Hub.

Designation would mean serving as a model for other villages and could result in grants for completing our center. ESLC and USDN will help Claiborne size and design back-up power systems to achieve 100% of our emergency power needs. Grant funding to purchase and install a photovoltaic generating and storage system and back-up generator power may become available. The next meeting will be at Claiborne Hall the week of October 22.
